Adverbs And Its Types With Examples

Definition

A word which qualifies anything except a noun or a pronoun is called adverb.

Examples: Daily, somewhere, quickly, calmly, everywhere, regularly, freely, silently, near, soon, nowhere etc.

- * I ate my dinner quickly.
- Bilal sees many puppies outside.
- * My father came house early.
- * I ate heavy meal.
- **She dresses** elegantly.

Adverb of time

Definition

The words which point out the time are called "adverbs of time.

Examples: Any time, now, before, late, soon, everyday, last week, last month, today, tomorrow, yesterday etc.

He will return soon.	وہ جلدوا پس آجائے گا۔
Bilal went there five minutes ago.	بلال پانچ منٹ پہلے وہاں گیا۔
We frequently go there.	ہم اکثر وہاں جاتے ہیں۔
He always plays foul.	وه ہمیشہ غلط کھیلتا ہے۔
He goes there every day.	وه روزانه و ہاں جاتا ہے۔

Adverb of place

Definition

It denotes place of an occurrence.

Examples: Here, there, where, over there, name of any place, Khanewal, Lahore etc.

The crow searched water everywhere.	کوے نے ہر جگہ یانی تلاش کیا۔
The cat is under the table.	بی میز کے نیچے ہے۔
He was sitting outside the room.	وہ کمرے کے باہر بیٹھاہے۔
I live in Khanewal.	میں خانیوال میں رہتا ہوں۔
This college is very famous.	بیر کالج بہت مشہور ہے۔

Adverb of manner

Definition

It denotes manner of an occurrence.

Examples: Well, badly, tightly, quickly, loudly, neatly, cleverly, correctly, roundly etc.

Ali acted very cleverly.	علی نے بڑی ہوشیاری سے کام کیا۔
Najma writes neatly.	نجمہ صاف صاف کھتے ہے۔
He answered me correctly.	اس نے مجھے درست طور پر جواب دیا۔
He angrily slaughtered his goat.	اس نے غصے سے اپنی بکری ذبح کر دی۔

Adverb of frequency

Definition

It denotes number of frequency.

Examples: Never, often, seldom, always, once, twice, again, thrice, sometime, secondly, and thirdly etc.

She seldom come here.	وہ تبھی کبھاریہاں آئی ہے۔
He goes there twice a day.	وہ دن میں دور قعہ وہاں جا تا ہے۔
They often come here.	وه اکثریهال آتے ہیں۔
I sometime meet them.	میں انہیں تبھی تبھی ملتا ہوں۔
She never come here.	وه تبھی بیہاں نہیں آئی۔

Adverb of degree

Definition

It denotes the quantity or degree.

Examples: Very, much, little, more, less, least, too, almost, partly, farther, quite, enough, fully somewhat, so wholly etc.

He is least interested in games.	وه کھیلوں میں کم دلچیپی رکھتا ہے۔
He is quite healthy now.	وہ اب بالکل صحت یاب ہے۔
I totally agree with you.	میں آپ سے مکمل منفق ہوں۔
It is extremely hot here.	یہاں بہت گرمی ہے۔
He completely changed my career.	اس نے میر ہے کیر بیڑ کو مکمل طور پر بدل دیا۔

Adverb of interrogative

Definition

It is used to ask questions.

Examples: Where, when, why, how, how many, what etc.

Where is Bilal?	بلال کہاں ہے؟
When did he go?	وه کب گیا؟
How did he solve this sum?	اس نے بیہ سوال کیسے حل کیا؟
How many trees are there in the garden?	باغ میں کتنے در خت ہیں؟

Adverb of relative

Definition

It is used to join two sentences.

Examples: Where, when, why, how, how many, what etc.

Do you know when he will reach?	کیا آپ جانتے ہیں کہ وہ کب آئے گا؟
Is this the place where I was born?	کیا بیہ وہی جگہ ہے جہاں میں ببید اہوا؟
Do you know where she lives?	کیا آپ جانتے ہیں کہ وہ کہاں رہتی ہے؟
I don't know when they came.	پینه نهیں وہ کب آئے۔

Adverb of negation

Definition

It affirms or negates something.

یہ کسی کام کے ہونے بانہ ہونے کو ظاہر کر تاہے۔

Examples: Yes, no, not, certainly, surely, probably, never, ever, indeed etc.

There was no boy in the room.	کمرے میں کوئی لڑکا نہیں تھا۔
It is not my table.	میری میر ^{نه} یں ہے۔
Indeed, he is a good man.	بے شک وہ اچھا آد می ہے۔
This book is not mine.	یے کتاب میری نہیں ہے۔
She never come here.	وه تبھی یہاں نہیں آئی۔
